COVID-19 STANDARD RESPONSE PROTOCOL



Prevention

No confirmed cases of COVID-19 among staff or Students

- Health prevention measures are in place as noted in the Blue Print
- Daily intensive cleaning and frequent cleaning of common areas.
- · Limited visitors' access.
- Monitoring virus trend in the community via Health Department and Texas Department of State Health Services and monitor Bay City ISD Attendance.



Mitigation

One or more confirmed case(s) of COVID-19 at one campus/ facility of in-person campus/ facility population and are unable to operate effectively with in-person learning.

- Communicate with person(s) who came within close contact of an individual with a confirmed case of COVID-19 will be personally contacted by health experts and advised to self-quarantine for 14 days.
- Affected areas will be closed for disinfection and deep cleaning.
- Self-screening of symptoms, prevention information and mitigation practices for all persons at the school facility.
- BCISD will notify all staff and parent(s) or guardian(s) on campus during any period of the exposure with health monitoring guidance.
- · If appropriate consider short term closure of facility



Modified Operations

3 or more confirmed COVID-19 cases in one specific area of in-person campus/ facility population and are unable to operate effectively with in-person learning. (i.e. Classroom; Group(s)

- Students and staff of the area will be advised to self-quarantine for 14 days.
- · Students impacted move to remote learning
- Affected area(s) are closed for disinfection and deep cleaning.
- Self-screening of symptoms, prevention information and stay at home if ill communication to all persons at the school facility.
- BCISD will notify all staff and parent(s) or guardian(s) on campus during any period of the exposure with health monitoring guidance.
- Consider a short-term closure of the affected area suspending large gatherings, field trips, ceremonies and
 other events.



Facility Closure

COVID-19 cases exceed 10% of the in-person campus/facility population of staff are unable to operate effectively with in-person learning.

- If appropriate, consider an entire facility will be closed as deemed necessary.
- Consider students and staff at this campus may return if symptom free upon determination by the school
 district and health authorities.
- Implement isolation for those in close contact of the confirmed COVID-19 positive case will be asked to selfquarantine for 14 days per CDC and/or TDSHS (Texas Department of State Health Services)
- Bay City ISD will notify all staff and parent(s) or guardian(s) on campus during any period of the exposure with health monitoring guidance.



District Closure

COVID-19 cases exceed 10% of in-person population in 3 campuses or staff are unable to operate effectively with in-person learning.

- If appropriate, consider all Bay City ISD facilities will be closed temporarily as deemed necessary.
- Students and staff will move to remote learning and work.
- Expand disinfection of all facilities and school buses.
- All auxiliary areas such as playgrounds and athletic facilities and fields are closed.
- Extracurricular activities are cancelled.
- BCISD will notify all staff and parent(s) or guardian(s) on campus during any period of the exposure with health monitoring guidance.
- * Decisions are made with the best information at the time & are subject to change with limited notice.
